Considering the verified Petition for Declaratory Relief and Injunctive Relief of Act 859 of the 2014 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature herein filed by plaintiff, Daniel A. Claitor, and the Court being satisfied from the specific facts therein appearing that the relief requested in warranted;

IT IS ORDERED, that a Temporary Restraining Order be issued to defendants, Honorable Bobby Jindal, Louisiana State Police Retirement System, Colonel Michael Edmonson, Louis Boquet and Honorable John Neely Kennedy, without hearing as permitted by La. C.C.P. art. 3603, and upon posting of a bond in the amount of \$2500.00, restraining, enjoining and prohibiting Honorable Bobby Jindal, Louisiana State Police Retirement System, Colonel Michael Edmonson, Louis Boquet and Honorable John Neely Kennedy from enforcing Act 859 of the 2014 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature or accepting benefits pursuant Act 859 of the 2014 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature prior to a preliminary and permanent hearing as Act 859 violates the Louisiana Constitution as set forth in the Petition for Declaratory Relief and Injunctive Relief of Act 859 of the 2014 Regular Session of the Louisiana Legislature herein filed by plaintiff, Daniel A. Claitor.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that this Temporary Restraining Order shall expire at the end of ten (10) days from the date hereof, unless extended by this Court prior to its expiration for good cause shown and the reasons therefor entered of record herein; and,

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that defendants, Honorable Bobby Jindal, Louisiana State Police Retirement System, Colonel Michael Edmonson, Louis Boquet and Honorable John Neely Kennedy, show cause before this Court on the 16 day of Sept, 2014, at 1:30 o'clock A.m. why a preliminary writ of injunction in the form and substance of the above Temporary Restraining Order should not issue, to be effective throughout these proceedings.


