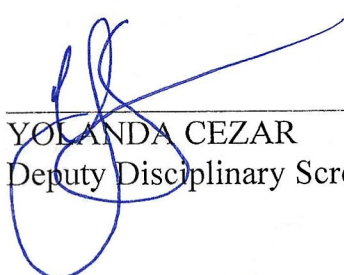
The Office of Disciplinary Counsel (ODC) has received and reviewed your complaint against the above-mentioned. This office is responsible for investigating, prosecuting and recommending disciplinary sanctions against Louisiana licensed attorneys who engage in misconduct or unethical activity or otherwise violate the Rules of Professional Conduct.

Our burden of proof is clear and convincing evidence. After reviewing your complaint, we have not found sufficient evidence of ethical misconduct rising to the level of a violation of the Rules of Professional Conduct to warrant the opening of a disciplinary investigation. Our office will be unable to assist you in this matter.

The ODC appreciates your concern for the maintenance of professional standards by all attorneys in our state. Your file in this matter is closed and will remain filed under the assigned administrative file number. In the event of future correspondence regarding this matter, please include this administrative file number.

You have the right to appeal this decision. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule XIX, §11(a), an appeal of the screening decision must be made in writing and shall be reviewable by the Chief Disciplinary Counsel, Anderson Dotson, III. Appeal decisions are within counsel's discretion and not otherwise subject to appellate review.
